The most significant factor for the development and prosperity of a nation is education, But in our country, over 3 crores people are not literates. Inhabitants of remote rural areas, forest lands, scheduled castes and tribes, advisers and those living in urban slums are leading a miserable and neglected life. They are neglected, deprived exploited and suffering socially, educationally and economically. It should be the duty of each citizen to make available all basic facilities- educational, cultural, concerning health, employment and to make them self-reliant, to inculcate Indian cultural and values and to work for communal harmony in society. Motivated by this feeling and considering the education, health, self-reliance moral, spiritual & cultural development as the basic needs of the people, I, Ashok K. Pal S/o Late Sh. Ripu Damanpaul, donate a sum of Rs. 11,100/- (Rs. Eleven thousand one hundred only) in cash. This amount shall remain as the first corpus fund of this Trust. This corpus will be cherished and grown for the fulfilment of the aims of this trust through grants, donations and gifts of movable and immovable property from government and non-government sources.

Aim of the Trust :

- 4 - Trust to run training/training institutions for teachers and other stake holders/schools/college/educational institutions and skill courses. To organise seminar/conferences etc. for public awareness.
- 4.1 - To protect/safe gaurd the people of remote villages, forest areas, scheduled castes/tribes, urban slums and those exploited and deprived socially, literally and financially. And for their all-round development through education, health, schools, trade centers, self-reliance programming and through Sanskar Kendras. The Trust will strive to run various social service projects in a planned way. It will also guide other such organizations working on similar lines with same objectives and will give/get support and financial help and also provide financial help to poor students.
- 4.2 To give support to the workers actively engaged and working selflessly with dedication towards mass-awakening and working in this direction.
- 4.3 To help and support the families of such workers in emergency and to arrange for the health care, food and lodging of social and full-time workers who have ideological and practical faith in the aims of the Trust.
- 4.4 To protect and give financial help to the educational and social organizations strengthening Indian culture and moral values. To HELP the poor and Brilliant Students to persue and complete their Education.
- 4.5 To run institutions for promoting education and for providing health care to the common people of remote rural, forest and border areas and to help such institutions in the form of grants and other means.

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- 4.6 To create an atmosphere so as to curb social and economic exploitation of the poor and the illiterates of forest and hilly areas.
- 4.7 To form study groups to awaken the masses towards actual problems of the above-mentioned neglected areas, to prepare, provide, propogate and advertise related literature and to give financial support for the smooth functioning of the study-groups.
- 4.8 To develop social responsibility among masses towards underdeveloped sections of the society through exhibition, debates, speeches, sermons, visual aids like video cassettes/CD's etc, and to support them for this work.
- 4.9 To provide possible help financially and otherwise and to work towards making them self-sufficient who are suffering due to natural calamities, draught, floods, earthquake, family, fire, epidemics and accidents.
- 4.10 To provide financial help and support to the organizations and trusts involved in conducting various religious activities of public interest.
- 4.11 To work for and give financial assistance for all religious activities of public interest which are undertaken for the benefit/welfare of mankind and our country.
- 4.12 To collect money publicly for the fulfillment of the aims, objectives and projects of the Trust, to receive donations, grants, to receive/give financial assistance from/to the religious/social organizations/Trusts.
- 4.13 To construct building for various projects, schools, hostels, hospitals, dispensaries on legally acquired lands or Trust land and to use and to get repairs on its building as and when required.
- 4.14 To accept donations, grants, movable and immovable gifts from government, non-government, social organizations and individuals for the fulfillment of the above-said aims of the Trust and for the smooth functioning and for promoting the service-capacity of the Trust.
- 4.15 To perform all the functions that are important and necessary according to trustees for the fulfillment of the above-said aims.

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5. **Initial Property :**

- 5.1 The initial property of this Trust is Rs. 11,000/-
5.2 Nature of the Trust : It will not be a family Trust. Rather, it shall be a charitable Trust of public interest made for the benefit and welfare of public at large.

6. **Trust Council/Board :**

- 6.1 Besides seven founder trustees as declared in this document, minimum two and maximum four other nominated Trustees will be taken as per the decision of the majority of founder trustees. Thus the total number of trustees should not exceed Eleven.
6.2 All the above-mentioned trustees shall collectively be called Trust council.

7. **Tenure of the Trustees :**

- 7.1 Seven founder member shall be the life members and the rest shall be nominated for three years term each.
7.2 On the completion of 3 years term, the formerly nominated member may again be nominated. Else new members/trustees will be nominated.
7.3 In case any member can not attend the meeting, he may send his views on agenda in writing to the chairman.

8. **Filling Vacancies of Founder Trustees** and office bearers :

In the event of any seat of founder trustee falling vacant, the other founder trustees will have the power to appoint some other person against that vacancy by their majority votes. The person, thus appointed, shall be considered as founder trustee. In case of resignation or the post of chairman fall vacant due to any reason, the vice chairman will function as chairman till the election of the Chairman.

9. **Dismissal of a Trustee :**

- 9.1 Any trustee who remains absent in five consecutive meetings without intimation shall be liable to be excluded from the Trust.
9.2 In such event, the other trustees shall be competent to nominate someone else in his/her place as per rules of the Trust.
9.3 Any Trustee working against the aims and objectives of the Trust may be dismissed/terminated on the basis of resolution passed with majority of the total trustees of the Trust.

10 **Rights & Duties of the Trust Council :**

- 10.1 The Trust Council shall enjoy the right to accept donations for fulfilling the Trust's objectives. The donations may be in the form of kind, cash, cheque, bank-draft, movable and immovable property. The acknowledgment will be given in the form of printed receipt duly signed by the Chairman /Secretary/Cashier of trust.
- 10.2 The Trust Council shall have the right to purchase, exchange, use or to rent out the property for the fulfillment of its aims.
- 10.3 The Trust Council shall enjoy the right to get loan for the functioning of the Trust and, if required, to lease out/mortgage the movable/immovable property of the Trust.
- 10.4 The Trust council shall have the right to receive or to extend aid, support and co-operation from/to other organizations with similar aims.
- 10.5 The Trust property can be donated only with the majority of the total number of trustees and with consent of organizing secretary and general secretary of VIDHYA BHARTI UTTER SHETAR.
- 10.6 The Trust council, when required, shall be competent to form, amend or to change such rules for the management, functioning of the trust as required for fulfillment of the aims of the Trust by majority decision.
- 10.7 The Trust council shall have the right to form/dismiss the committees for organized functioning of the Trust.
- 10.8 These committees may include individuals other than the trustees. The rights and duties of these committees will be prescribed by the Trust council.
- 10.9 The Trust council shall have the right to form service rules for its employees as and when required.
- 10.10 No Trustee will accept salary/pay except the traveling allowance or/and other lawful expenses incurred by him/her for the Trust work.
- 10.11 All expenses made of court issues, cases or proceedings related to Trust shall be borne by the Trust.

10.12 Financial or any other possible loss to anyone while performing the Trust work shall be borne by the Trust and for that loss, no trustees will be held responsible personally unless he/she has done it deliberately.

10.13 The founder of the Trust has willfully formed this Trust keeping in view the good of humanity and our country and inspired by Hindu philosophy of life and motivated by a sense of social responsibility. The founder himself or the Trust council shall not be competent to dissolve this Trust and incase trust is dissolved, its whole property shall be transferred to Vidya Bharti Uttar Kshetar, Kurukshetra HRKKR201500388.

11 **Formation of working Committee :**

11.1 The Chairman, Secretary and the Treasurer (collectively called the working committee) will be elected by simple majority of the Trust council. The Chairman will be one from the founder member only.

11.2 Other two members of working committee will be elected from the Trust council if required.

11.3 I declare the office- bearers of the first working committee of this Trust as under. These office- bearers will remain in office for three years from the date of formation of this Trust. Before the completion of three years, the Trust council will elect office bearers for the next term in accordance with the above given rules and regulations.

12 **System of Working :**

12.1 There shall be a working committee for the smooth working of the Trust. It will have Chairman, Secretary and Cashier as and two other members.

12.2 The functions/duties of the office bearers will be as under-
Chairman of the Trust : To preside over the meeting of the Trust council and working committee, to use his special vote in the event of equal votes. To sign all appointments.

Secretary of the Trust : The Secretary will be the managing Trustee. He/she will call the meetings, fulfill responsibilities of executive manager, look after the working, activities and interests of the Trust. Note the minutes of the meetings and get their approval. Monitor income and expenditure. Represent Trust in all types of legal actions.

Treasurer : To prepare budget and get approval/sanction from the Trust council, to manage and control income and expenditure accordingly. To get the income-expenditure audited and present the same in the meeting of the Trust council.

- 12.3 Only the office bearers of the working committee will be the office bearers of Trust council.
- 12.4 The tenure of the members of the working committee will be for three years. No office bearer will remain on one post more than twice.
- 12.5 The secretary of the working committee will be the managing Trustee of the Trust.
- 12.6 The Managing Trustee will be the executive officer of the Trust and will have the right to run day-to-day affairs of the Trust as advised by the working committee of the Trust, on behalf of the Trust. The Managing Trustee will represent the Trust in any court case/hearing filed by/against the Trust. If required, the Trust council, by majority, can give the right of representation to any other person/Trustee on behalf of the Trust.
- 12.7 All the documents, record, treasury will be handed over/transferred by the former office bearers to the newly elected/appointed office bearers after completion of their term or in case of dismissal from the post.

13. **Meetings, Information and Quorum :**

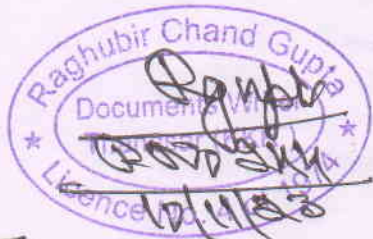
- 13.1 At least one meeting of Trust council every year will be held which will be called the annual session. Presence of five members will be required to complete the quorum.
- 13.2 In case the quorum is incomplete, the Trust council meeting may be held without quorum on the same place after half an hour of the suspended meeting but only those subjects mentioned in the agenda will be taken for consideration.

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- 13.3 Minimum two meetings of the working committee will be called in a year. The quorum will be three members.
- 13.4 15 days prior notice to the Trust council and working committee meeting will be mandatory. However if necessary the Chairman/Secretary/Managing Trustee may call an emergency meeting of the Trust council/working committee on a short notice.
- 13.5 Except those subjects which require majority of the total number of trustees, in all other subjects, decisions may be taken by simple majority of the trustees present.
- 13.6 If a proposal is passed by required majority through circulation it shall be as valid as any other rule passed in a meeting.
- 13.7 The financial year of the Trust will start from 1st April every year and end in 31st March.
14. **Bank Account** : Account/Accounts of the Trust will be opened in any scheduled Bank recommended by the working committee and the same will be operated with the signatures of any two of the Chairman, the Secretary, the treasurer.
15. **Audit** : The annual account, inspection and audit of all the accounts of the Trust will be done by the Chartered Accountant approved by the Trust council. The working committee will, itself, fix his fees etc.

I, again declare that to form the above-said 'VIDYA BHARTI INSTITUTE OF TRAINING & RESEARCH TRUST' is my final decision which shall neither be with drawn/reversed by me or any of my heirs nor shall this Trust be dissolved. The sum of Rs. 11,100/- donated by me is now the property of this Trust and have been entered/placed in the Trust Council. Thus the Trust Council will use and invest this amount properly for the fulfillment of the aims of this Trust.

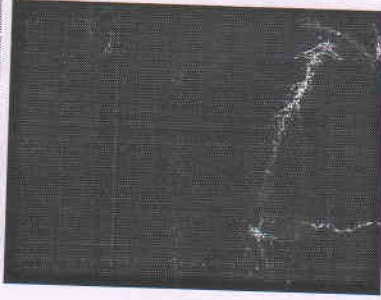
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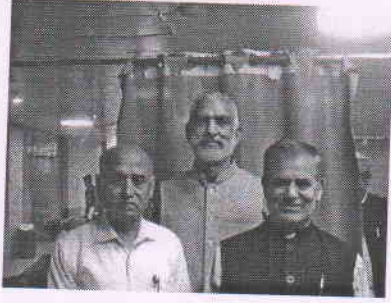


